Nomination

To nominate your students you should send us an e-mail containing, at least, the name and surname of the students and their e-mail address. Following the nomination we will contact the students to send them instructions on how to apply in our on-line application form.

Incoming students are required to have at least an **intermediate level (B1)** of the teaching language for the chosen degree. Since we will ask the candidates to provide proof of their language knowledge, it would be very useful if you check about it before the nomination. The teaching languages for the different degrees are:

- Bachelor in Informatics Engineering (http://www.fib.upc.edu/en/estudiar-enginyeria-informatica/assignatures.html): Spanish/Catalan/English (*)
- Master in Artificial Intelligence (http://www.fib.upc.edu/en/masters/mai/syllabus.html): English
- Master in Informatics Engineering (http://www.fib.upc.edu/en/masters/mei/syllabus.html): Spanish/Catalan
- Master in Innovation and Research in Informatics (http://www.fib.upc.edu/en/masters/miri/syllabus.html): English
- (*) A few of the courses of the Bachelor in Informatics Engineering are taught in English. But the offer in English is not so large and it cannot be assured for the following academic period because it is part of a pilot project, which is being evaluated every semester. Thus, in terms of teaching language, the Bachelor in Informatics Engineering is considered an Spanish/Catalan taught degree.
