Health insurance requirements and costs	Do you required students to have a health insurance? YES it's compulsory if you stay more than 3 months AND if you don't have the European card of health insurance. In this case, students must take the insurance during the Welcome Session. (215 € in 2016). In addition, students must subscribe while being in their home country an International Medical Health Insurance translated into French or English. This insurance shall be valid: 1. until August 31 st if the student arrives in July or August OR 2. until the 1 st day of the month following his/her arrival (Ex: if he/she arrive on October 4 th , valid until November 1 st)
Accommodation	The International Office (DRI) of INSA Toulouse does not manage the booking the accommodation any longer: students shall find it and book it by themselves. We provide information and a list of accommodations to help students. Students can also contact the Toul'box service to help them find an accommodation ("All-in" Package – 200€ in 2016)
