Passport/Visa requirements	Passport/Visa requirements
Residency Requirements	If you are a non-EU national wishing to visit or travel within the EU,
	you will need a passport:
	<ul> <li>valid for at least 3 months after the date you intend to leave</li> </ul>
	the EU country you are visiting,
	<ul> <li>which was issued within the previous 10 years,</li> </ul>
	and possibly a visa. Apply for a visa from the consulate or embassy of
	the country you are visiting. If your visa is from a "Schengen area"
	country, it automatically allows you to travel to the other Schengen
	countries as well. If you have a valid residence permit from one of
	those Schengen countries, it is equivalent to a visa. You may need a
	national visa to visit non-Schengen countries.
	Residency requirements:
	Once in Ávila, all students no matter their nationality will have to
	apply for a "Residency Permit" at an Ávila Police Station.
Medical Insurance	All students must have a medical policy that insures them the whole
	time that they are in Spain.
