Nomination Deadline (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: 15th of June Second semester (Spring semester): 15th of November

Nomination will include the following information	Name and surname; ID/passport number; date of birth; gender, e-mail address; exchange period requested and study field			
Online registration (compulsory)	After the nomination, the student will receive an email with a link to do the <b>online application.</b>			
Documents the student should upload to the online application before your arrival	<ul> <li>Learning agreement</li> <li>Copy of ID or passport</li> <li>Required insurance document</li> <li>European Insurance Card (if possible)</li> </ul>			
Deadline for online registration by the students (compulsory)	First semester (Autumn semester) or full academic year: 30th of June Second semester (Spring semester): 30th of November
