



ERASMUS+ 2019/2020 FACTSHEET (Medicine and Dental Medicine)

1. ADMISSION CRITERIA

You can apply to the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Medicine as an exchange student for one or two semesters in case your home university is a partner university of the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Medicine. 2. APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

1. **ERASMUS+**: Your home university should first nominate you to the Office of International Relations of the University of Ljubljana. The nominations should be sent to **intern.office@uni-lj.si**

OTHERS: Your home university should nominate you to the international office of the Faculty of Medicine, **international.erasmus@mf.uni-lj.si**

2. After your home university has nominated you to study at the University of Ljubljana as an exchange student, you should fill in an online application. There is no need to send a paper copy of the application.

3. At the end of the online application you will find the necessary documents to upload to your application: Transcript of Records (of your home university), Learning Agreement and Language Certificate. Your application is complete and will be processed only after you have followed all the steps of the application system and entered all the required information.

4. After we have received your application and your host department has approved your application, we will send you an Acceptance letter and information on living and studying in Ljubljana.

APPLICATION DEADLINES

15 May 2019 for the winter semester/full academic year

15 November 2019 for the summer semester

3. ACADEMIC CALENDER

The Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ljubljana organises on the basis of different block courses that is why there is no fixed line between the autumn and spring semester. The start and the end of the semester actually depend from the selected courses.

The courses of the first semester 2019/2020 will start on 30. 09. 2019, only the course Fundamentals of Investigative methods (Radiology modul) will be organised in the last week of September.

The spring semester starts in the middle of February 2020 and lasts until June 28th 2020. Examination periods are organised immediately after the courses end so the students can do most of the exams during the academic year.

Lectures free period: 31 October – 1 November 2019, 25 and 26 December 2019, 1 and 2 January 2020, 8 February 2019, 13 April 2020, 27 April 2020, 1 and 2 May 2020.

4. AVAILABLE COURSES IN MEDICINE AND DENTAL MEDICINE

Faculty of Medicine offers to its exchange students a selection of courses organised in English. Those courses are organised only once per year in a prefixed time period.

The available courses in Dental medicine are only available in the autumn semester 2019/2020 so students without the knowledge of Slovene language can only come in the autumn semester.

6. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The Faculty of Medicine offers to the exchange students instruction in the English.

The Faculty of Medicine requires that the student has very good language skills (very good knowledge in reading, writing and speaking of the language) in English in order to be able to study here. Please note that fluent language skills in English are vital for successful studies at the Faculty of Medicine. If the language requirements are not met, the faculty will not accept you.

Students must present a language certificate of their English language skills. Very good language skills refer to level B2 on the CEFR scale of the European Language Portfolio Levels.

How to prove the language skills in English

Language skills are listed on the Transcript of Records of the home university; or

Submit the Language Certificate with CEFR scale; or

Submit TOEFL score of 79 (IBT) or IELTS score of 6 for English, or any official certificate

SLOVENE LANGUAGE COURSE FOR ERASMUS+ STUDENTS

Before the start of the semester the Centre for Slovene as a second and foreign language organises the Slovene language course for Erasmus+ incoming students. SLOVENE LEARNING ONLINE

Slovene Learning Online is a freely accessible online course of Slovene for foreigners, developed at the Centre for Slovene as a Second and Foreign Language in cooperation with the company DigiEd. The course is designed for those who wish to learn Slovene on their own in a simple, playful and effective way.

7. ACCOMMODATION

Student dormitories (ERASMUS)

Erasmus+ students can apply for a bed in student dormitories. Beds are given to students on “first come first serve” basis. The rooms are double, with shared bathroom and shared kitchen. The access to internet is available in all the dormitories. The price of the room depends on the type of

the apartment and size of the room. Available dorms are Dom IV, Dom XIV in Rožna dolina and Dom D in Bežigrad. The average price per person per month in a double room is 120-190 EUR.

HOW TO APPLY: fill in the Information on Housing in the online application by 15 May (first semester/full year) or 15 November (second semester) - "first come first serve" basis applies to online application! The application for housing can be done separately so you can apply well in advance. Don't wait for the deadline, because the places are very limited!

Private accommodation

It is very difficult to find private accommodation in Ljubljana so you should start well in advance. The Student Organization of the University of Ljubljana will help you in your search for private accommodation after your arrival to Ljubljana. They will advise you and give you information on where and how to look for accommodation, but the search will be done by you. Before your departure you should book yourself a hostel at least for the first week. After the arrival you can visit the International Office of the Student Organization (Kampus, Pivovarniška 6, office hours: Tuesday 2pm-5pm, Wednesday 2pm - 5pm, Thursday 2pm - 5pm), but firstly you should contact them by e-mail: rooms@sou-lj.si; findmeroom@gmail.com

Using the platform itself is completely free for you as a student; when you make a concrete booking an administrative fee will be charged as a part of Housing Anywhere's secure booking system.
