Student exchange information

COST OF LIVING. The cost of an academic year depends on several factors. Based on the experiences of previous incoming exchange students the cost of living average is between CHF 900 and CHF 1200 per month.

VISA. Depending on their nationality, visitors must fulfil different entry conditions. All foreign students are required to register with the Residents Registration's Office within 14 days of their arrival. If they intend to work, they need a work permit. Visiting students from abroad who are interested in spending an exchange semester or doing an internship at the ZHAW take personal responsibility for all matters related to insurance, including health, accident and liability insurance. The recommended level is B2 for bachelor level and B2+ for master level. The international coordinator at the home university is responsible for confirming the ability in the language(s) required.

Transcript of Records ToR:

The ZHAW LSFM will issue the Transcript of Records (ToR) no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished. The ToR will be sent to the student and his/her home institution by e-mail only (unless the original is requested).
