	The ZIB Jura will send a transcript to each exchange-student within about three months after the end of the term (Corrections of the exams take a lot of time).		
LIVING EXPENSES			
Housing	<p>The “Kölner Studierendenwerk” offers student housing in different quarters of Cologne. The rent varies according to the size and the location of the room between 210 and 400 euros. There is no guaranty that students will be offered a room in student housing.</p> <p>Students should apply for a room on the website: https://www.kstw.de/wohnen</p> <p>Students may also arrange housing on their own. The rent is usually higher than the rent of the student housing offers.</p>		
Food	<p>On the campus, students can find different canteens offering hot meals for lunch and dinner as well as salad bars or snacks. The price for one meal is between 2,60 – 4,50 euros.</p>		
Transportation	<p>The Students Identity Card of the University of Cologne includes a bus and train ticket for the city of Cologne and the whole region North Rhine-Westphalia during the semester term. It is contained within the social fee which students have to pay obligatorily.</p>
