School of Media Design - Course Offer 2023/2024

You are expected to choose **one** course from the core offer; this choice should be communicated with the Media Design Department before the arrival in Ravensburg. Furthermore, you can choose **one or more** courses from the electives; they are usually courses with both an introduction and tutoring in class in English language; Elective bilingual classes, have introductions in German, but the student will be closely supervised by a tutor in English. You encouraged to choose **one or more** self-directed projects to achieve the amount of credits required by your home university. Our course offer for the fall and spring term is limited compared to the winter and summer term. One further option might be to combine for instance the summer term with the fall term in order to spread out one semester workload over two quarter terms.
