Students will apply for these courses once they arrive at UAM through an online form.</p> <p><i>What is the min. and max. course load?</i></p> <p>Minimum is 10 ECTS per semester, 20 ECTS per academic year. Maximum is 30 ECTS per semester, 60 ECTS per academic year.</p> <p><i>How do students need to register for the courses?</i></p> <p>Students need to reserve their spot online through the course selection website during July (Fall Semester & Full Academic year students) or December (Spring Semester students).</p>
