Approximate cost of accommodation per month	University's dormitories – 575 – 650 PLN (120 - 140 €) Private room - 800 – 1200 PLN (170 - 260 €) Private studio/apartment – 1800 - 2500 PLN (380 - 530 €)
Booking procedure	Exchange students apply for accommodation in University's dormitories through application form. Confirmation of getting a place is sent in July/December by International Relations Office. Poznań University of Economics and Business does not act as an intermediary in the rental of private accommodation. Student should contact the chosen institution/landlord independently.
Pick-up service upon arrival/ Buddy System	The student mentors arranged by ESN UE Poznań meet the exchange students on arrival and provide support at the beginning of their stay in Poznań.
Social programme	Trips to other Polish cities, social events and sport activities are organised by ESN UE Poznań student association.
