Application deadlines	For all programmes, except for Music programmes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Autumn semester and academic year: 15 May - Spring semester: 15 November For Music programmes, the application deadline is 31 March for semester or full year.

Procedure	<p>To apply for a study period at SUPSI, students must be nominated by their home institutions. Applications are only accepted via Mobility Online, with relevant information provided to partner institutions via email. Language of instruction		<p>The official language is Italian. However, selected Bachelor courses, workshops and practice sessions, as well as full Master degree courses, may be held in English. Physiotherapy courses at Physiotherapie Graubünden in Landquart are held in German. Courses at the FFHS are taught in German, with some exceptions in English.</p>
Italian courses		<p>An optional two-week intensive Italian course is offered free of charge to European exchange students twice a year before the beginning of classes (in August-September and in February).</p>

Accommodation	<p>SUPSI does not have a Student Residence, but gives support to international students with private contacts or web links through the Student Portal.</p>
Approximate monthly costs in Swiss Francs (CHF)	<p>Shared single room or one-bedroom apartment (450-800.-) Food and other household expenses (450.-) Recreation and travel (150.-) Health insurance is required (90-280.-)</p>
SEMP program	<p>Since 2014, student mobility in European and Swiss universities under the Erasmus+ programme and Swiss-European Mobility Programme (SEMP) has been regulated. SEMP permits a maximum of 12 months for study and/or internships per study cycle, including mobility within the Erasmus+ programme. Any months utilized in these programs will be subtracted from the remaining eligible funding. Currently, postgraduate incoming mobility is not funded.</p> <p>More information at following link</p>
Visa , permits and health insurance	<p>Non-EU students must ask for a student visa as soon as they receive the letter of acceptance from SUPSI.</p> <p>All exchange students must apply for a residence permit ("L-Permit") upon arrival in Switzerland. More information about student visas and resident permits, please visit here.</p> <p>In Switzerland, private health insurance is compulsory for all residents. We recommend to have also a personal liability insurance coverage.</p> <p>Students who are temporarily resident in Switzerland and have a comparable foreign insurance may be exempted from this rule.</p>
