



Erasmus+ SMS (Studies) Mobility at l'Université Grenoble Alpes (UGA) – Faculty of Pharmacy 2024-2025

How can students come on Erasmus+ SMS Mobility to the Faculty of Pharmacy?

Step 1: Nomination by the sending university

All students wishing to come to UGA on Erasmus+ SMS mobility must be nominated by their home university during the following nomination periods:

- For mobility in the 1st semester* / full year : from March 15th to April 30th, 2024
- For mobility in the 2nd semester* only : from August 30th to September 30th, 2024

Please note that nominations received outside of the specified deadlines will not be accepted.

(*Semester 1 = end of August/beginning of September to January; Semester 2 = mid-end January to May/June/beginning of July depending on courses chosen and exam dates)

Step (2): Online application by the student

Students will be contacted by the Academic Coordinator following their nomination in order to confirm that a study program which corresponds to the student's level and requirements can be proposed. If this is the case, the student will then be sent a link to the online application platform as well as other relevant information regarding the organization of their mobility at UGA and specifics for the Faculty of Pharmacy. Students must then complete their online application by the deadline.

Online application periods:

- From March 15th to May 30th, 2024 (for 1st semester and full year students)
- From September 15th to October 18th, 2024 (for 2nd semester students)

Step ③: Acceptance and pre-arrival procedures

Students will receive an email from the International Relations Coordinator at UGA once their application has been validated. This email will include the official acceptance letter to UGA (in French and in English) and any other important information concerning the formalities of their mobility.

Step ④: Learning agreement confirmation by the IRO at UGA and next steps

The students will confirm with the Academic Coordinator as to which courses will make up their study program at UGA. They can then complete and validate their Learning Agreement (LA) by their home university and have it signed by UGA.
