	 All internationally recognized language certificates such as TOEFL, Goethe etc. English or German courses at the required level (B2) as noted in student's Transcript of Records Confirmation issued by home university in regards to student's language skills (German OR English) at the required level B2
Workload	A full workload corresponds to 30 ECTS credits per semester. Exchange students are expected to take a minimum workload of 20 ECTS credits per semester.
Transcript of records	The Transcript of Records is signed with an official electronic signature and can be downloaded by the students directly from our Kepler University Study Support System.
