Each year, roughly one of every two university diplomas in French-speaking Belgium is awarded by UCLouvain.

The 3,600 UCLouvain researchers represent an impressive pool of knowledge and skills. Their quality can be measured by the number of European Research Council (ERC) grants, the European grants of excellence, that they win each year: in 2023, they numbered 56. UCLouvain scientists also benefit from the LouvainTRANSFER "turnkey" service for promoting their research

# Innovative and open teaching

At UCLouvain, teachers are encouraged to place innovation at the core of their teaching. To this end, they can count on the support of the Louvain Learning Lab (LLL), a leader in its field. In addition, since sharing knowledge with as many people as possible is one of its key missions, the university has placed open science and open education at the centre of an ambitious digital transformation project.
