Online Application Guide for Erasmus+ Incoming Students

Step 1: Apply through this link: https://www.unic.ac.cy/apply/ (screenshot 1)


→ Programme of interest: Select "Erasmus".

DO NOT select the programme of studies of which you are studying at your Home University (i.e. Business Administration), choose "Erasmus"!

Make sure to select the correct semester, which is: "FALL 2025"

Students that will be studying at UNIC for the whole Academic Year 2025/26, should select only "FALL 2025". Do not select both FALL 2025 and SPRING 2026.

Step 2: Once you complete the requested information and create a Password (step 1), please press "Submit". In a few seconds you will automatically be transferred and have access to "CRM platform" to complete the rest of your online application. (screenshot 2)



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


Once you click on "Complete Application" the "Application Checklist" will appear (Screenshot 4).

No 3 and No 4 DOES NOT apply to Erasmus incoming students, therefore, please ignore it!

Step 4: Once you click "Submit Online Application" (screenshot 4) the below "Personal Information" page, will appear (Screenshot 5), which you are requested to complete.

You should **ONLY complete**: Tab 1: <u>"Personal Information"</u> (screenshot 5) and Tab 2: <u>"Programme Information"</u> (screenshot 6).

On "Personal Information" it is important to upload your photo, as it will be used to create your UNIC Student ID card later on!



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
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Step 6: Now you are ready to proceed with section 2 on "Application Checklist" and submit all "Relevant Documents" as shown on screenshot 10.

Supporting Application Documents details:

- 1. Official Transcript of Records/Progress Report in English (from Home institution)
- 2. Small photo in JPEG or PNG format
- 3. Official Certificate/Proof of English Language Proficiency (If no official certification is in place (i.e., IGCSE, IELTS, TOEFL, etc.), you may send us a confirmation from your Home University stating your English level). (UNIC English Requirements can be found here)
- 4. Copy of the identity page of passport or ID
- 5. Consent for the Personal Data Processing Form (CPD Form). The form can be found here.
- → Complete only your name/surname, ID, signature, and date.
- → DO NOT complete anything on "Guardian/Sponsor" part and "Authorized third party" part.
- 6. Copy of European Health Insurance Card or Private Health Insurance that covers your entire mobility period at UNIC.
- 7. Health History Form (document can be found here)
- 8. Other Files (NOT COMPULSORY): Provisional Online Learning Agreement (OLA)/Learning Agreement (LA). For more information, please see here ("OLA-LA Information Guide").

Finally, once you submit all supporting documents, then on the "Application Checklist" sections 1 and 2 will become "Orange".

Once your documents will be reviewed by our Office, sections 1 and 2 will become "Green" and you will be notified via email, that your online application is complete. If anything is missing we will notify you via email.

The online application and supporting documents will be reviewed after the application deadline

Deadlines to submit your Online Application

→ Fall Semester or/and Full Academic Year: May 30th

→ Spring Semester: October 30th

*Late applications will not be accepted!


*The Letters of Acceptance will be sent via email three-four weeks after the application deadline.

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



VISA Process for Non-EU Student coming from a Non-EU country and EU country

All non-EU students have to contact the International Admissions office at int.admissions@unic.ac.cy, the soonest, regarding the Student Entry permit application guidelines and deadlines.

Non-EU students will not be allowed to enroll for Erasmus at UNIC if they do not apply for a student Entry permit through the International Admissions office at UNIC prior to traveling to Cyprus.

Please do not use your Schengen visa for study purposes.
