Information housing procedure	<p>HU has agreements with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - SSH Short Stay, a local housing corporation that reserves a (limited!) range of temporary furnished rooms for specifically international students - Xior, which is another corporation specialised in student accommodation. Here too the number of rooms is limited. Xior rooms are intended for Full-Year students only! - <p>More information on housing and application deadlines can be found here: https://www.internationalhu.com/reserved-housing.</p>
Deadlines for housing application	<p>Students are advised to apply for housing as soon as it becomes available. Rooms are allocated on a 'first come first serve' basis as rooms are limited. Students should beware scams while looking for private rooms! Deals that sound too good to be true usually are! Official housing corporations do not charge rent up front.</p>
Housing costs	<p>Booking fee SSH Short Stay: € 95 Registration/administration fee Xior: €100</p> <p>Rental fees are between € 600 - € 1200 per month and include utilities (water, heating, internet, electricity). Sleeping and kitchen utensils are not included.</p>
