I bandi "ERC Advanced Grants" in breve:

- Settore di ricerca: qualsiasi settore scientifico, tecnico e accademico
- Ricercatori: di qualsiasi età e nazionalità. I richiedenti devono essere scientificamente indipendenti, vantare un curriculum di attività di ricerca recente e avere un profilo che li identifichi come leader del/i rispettivo/i settore/i di ricerca
- Criterio di valutazione: eccellenza scientifica
- Istituzione ospitante: le attività di ricerca devono essere svolte presso un'organizzazione di ricerca pubblica o privata (nota come "istituzione ospitante") situata in uno degli Stati membri dell'UE o dei paesi associati
- Finanziamento: fino a € 2,5 milioni per borsa di ricerca (in alcuni casi fino a € 3,5 milioni per borsa di ricerca)
- Durata: fino a 5 anni

In the context of the **European Innovation Partnership (EIP) on raw materials**, the European Commission is undertaking an online survey to get an overview on all ongoing and recently completed research and innovation activities (e.g. programmes, projects) related to raw materials <http://goo.gl/FMe0dF>

The inputs received will help to monitor the state of implementation of the various actions proposed by the EIP in its **Strategic Implementation Plan**.

The survey consists of a short section of general questions about the programme or project and a specific section of tailor-made questions depending on the nature of the programme or project, following the structure of the EIP's priority areas:

- Raw materials research and innovation coordination
- Technologies for primary and secondary raw materials production
- Substitution of raw materials
- Improving Europe's raw materials framework conditions
- Improving Europe's waste management framework conditions and excellence
- Knowledge, skills and raw materials flows
- International cooperation

The purpose of the survey is to do a mapping exercise of efforts made in the various EIP action areas. Our analysis of the survey results will then enable us to identify potential gaps and to find ways to overcome fragmentation and to streamline different instruments and initiatives. Completion of the survey should take no more than **15 minutes**. The survey will be open until **11 March 2015** through the European Commission's survey portal:

The European Commission, DG Research & Innovation is organising a workshop "**A European Roadmap for Climate Services**" taking place in Brussels on 17th March 2015. This workshop is the **first public occasion to present the Roadmap** to the stakeholders and key players in the field, share views, discuss the challenges and opportunities, and move towards its implementation.

The Roadmap is the result of the work of an *ad hoc* Expert Group, which has been established by the EC, as one of the main outcomes of the workshop "Towards a European Market for Climate Services" (Brussels 18 March 2014). It is not a European Commission document, but relies on the involvement of a larger supporting group – including the EC services, Copernicus and the EIT Climate KIC – and on a focused stakeholders' consultation.

The Roadmap will be published by the end of February 2015, and will be available on the workshop website.
