ACT OF COMMITMENT

Open procedure with application of the criterion of the most economically advantageous offer identified on the basis of the best quality-price ratio, pursuant to articles 71 and 108, Legislative Decree no. 36/2023 and subsequent amendments in one lot having as its object the supply of microwave measurement electronics for the characterization of superconducting quantum devices for the NQSTI project in the university complex of Monte Sant'Angelo, Naples

_____ participant (hereinafter "Competitor") in the open tender procedure, Lot _____, to be awarded with the criterion of the most economically advantageous offer, pursuant to articles 71 and 108, paragraph 1 of Legislative Decree no. 36/2023 and subsequent amendments for the "supply of microwave measurement electronics for the characterization of superconducting quantum devices NQSTI" within the scope of the "National Quantum Science and Technology Institute" project - NQSTI – CUP E63C22002190007, considering that:

- with MUR decree no. 3264 of 28 December 2021, the Public Notice was issued for the submission of project proposals for "Strengthening and creation of Research Infrastructures" to be financed under the PNRR Mission 4, "Education and research" - Component 2, "From research to business" - Investment line 1.3, "Fund for the creation of an integrated system of research and innovation infrastructures", financed by the European Union - NextGenerationEU;
- in response to the aforementioned Public Notice, the University participated as a partner in the proposal "National Quantum Science and Technology Institute" called "NQSTI" marked with the identification code PE00000023 with the University of Camerino as the lead partner;
- within the scope of the "NQSTI" Project, with identification code "PE00000023", the purchase of electronic equipment for the measurement and characterization of quantum superconducting devices is planned;

- with contracting decision no. 57051 of 30/04/2025, this Administration has ordered to proceed with the announcement of an open tender procedure, to be awarded with the criterion of the most economically advantageous offer, pursuant to articles 71 and 108, Legislative Decree no. 36/2023 and subsequent amendments for the "Supply of microwave measurement electronics for the characterization of superconducting quantum devices";

with this Act

the operator identified in the epigraph expressly and irrevocably assumes all - without exception - the following constraints, burdens and commitments and, therefore, declares pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 and subsequent amendments, aware of the criminal sanctions referred to in art. 76 of the same decree:

1. to have full knowledge of the Tender Documentation, to accept and comply with all the provisions contained therein;
2. to undertake (where he/she employs a number equal to or greater than fifty employees and is required to draw up a report on the personnel situation pursuant to art. 46 of Legislative Decree 11 April 2006, no. 198), to produce, under penalty of exclusion, a copy of the last report drawn up, with certification of its conformity with the one possibly sent to the company trade union representatives and to the regional councillor and equality councillor, or, in the event of non-compliance with the terms set out in paragraph 1 of the same art. 46, with certification of its simultaneous transmission to the company trade union representatives and to the regional councillor and equality councillor;
3. to undertake (where he/she employs a number equal to or greater than fifteen employees and not more than fifty and is not required to draw up a report on the personnel situation, pursuant to Article 46 of Legislative Decree No. 198 of 11 April 2006) to deliver, within six months of the conclusion of the contract, a gender report on the situation of male and female personnel in each of the professions and in relation to the status of hiring, training, professional promotion, levels, category or qualification changes, other mobility phenomena, the intervention of the Cassa Integrazione Guadagni, dismissals, early retirements and retirements, the remuneration actually paid and to transmit the aforementioned to the company trade union representatives and to the regional councilor for equality, under penalty of the application of the penalties referred to in Article 47, paragraph 6 of Legislative Decree No. 77 of 31 May 2021, converted with amendments by Law No. 108 of 29 July 2021;
4. to undertake (if it employs fifteen or more employees) to deliver, within six months of the conclusion of the contract, a report clarifying the fulfillment of the obligations set out for companies by Law 12 March 1999, no. 68, and illustrating any sanctions and measures imposed on companies in the three-year period preceding the deadline for submitting offers. The economic operator is also required to send the report to the company trade union representatives, under penalty of the application of the penalties referred to in art. 47, paragraph

6, of Legislative Decree 31 May 2021 no. 77, converted with amendments by Law 29 July 2021 no. 108;

5. to undertake (in the event of the award of the tender procedure in its favor) to ensure:

- a quota equal to 30% of the hiring necessary for the execution of the contract or for the implementation of activities connected to it or instrumental to youth employment (under 36 years);

- a quota equal to 30% of the hiring necessary for the execution of the contract or for the implementation of activities connected to it or instrumental to female employment.

6. to undertake to observe the specific obligations of the PNRR, including the principle of not causing significant harm to the environmental objectives so-called "Do No Significant Harm" (DNSH) pursuant to Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2020/852 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 June 2020, as well as in reference to the "Operational Guide" attached to the MEF Circular of 13 October 2022, no. 33.
