Credit system

The university credit system follows the European ECTS credit system. The average annual workload of a full-time student corresponds to 60 credits in every academic year, it makes 30 ECTS in one semester.

The maximum number of ECTS for incoming Erasmus and non-Erasmus students is 30 per semester! *(Double-degree and joint-degree students can be awarded an exception)*

Grading system
