Semester Dates

Autumn semester: First week of October – First week of February
Spring semester: Third week of February - First week June

Semester dates include both teaching and examination periods

All students are supposed to be in Barcelona a week before the start of their studies for welcome meetings and enrollment.

Nomination Procedure

All applicants must be officially nominated by their home institution.

The partner institution nominates students via e-mail

Partner institutions can nominate students for autumn semester or spring semester. Students on autumn semester can extend their exchange period on spring semester, if places are available.

Nominations periods and deadlines

Autumn semester: 2nd March – 14th April

Spring semester: October 15th onwards

Autumn semester: Second week of June
Spring semester: First week of November
