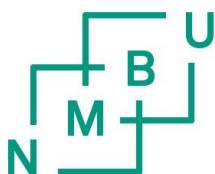

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The autumn semester is organized in 2 periods:

- August block (one intensive three-week course in August)
- Autumn parallel (September – December)
- Exams period for Autumn parallel: 2 weeks in December

The spring semester is organized in 3 periods:

- January block (one intensive three-week course in January)
- Spring parallel (February – May)
- Exams period for Spring parallel: 2 weeks in May
- June block (one intensive three-week course in June)

During the blocks it is only possible to take one course, since all the exams of the block will take place on the same day, usually at the end of block period. It is not mandatory to sign up for a course in the blocks.

The students can meet the fulltime studies requirement of 30 ECTS/semester by taking courses in the parallels. However, they are welcome to participate in the blocks as well.
