



STUDENTS CALL FOR APPLICATION

GIVEN the Law of August 2nd, 1990, n. 241 “Nuove norme in materia di procedimento amministrativo e di diritto di accesso ai documenti amministrativi” [“New regulations on administrative procedures and the right of access to administrative documents”] and subsequent amendments and/or additions;

GIVEN the applicable University Statute;

GIVEN the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data - hereinafter EU Regulation 2016/679 - relating to the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data, and the related National legislation of the Code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree N. 196/2003, as modified and integrated by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018;

CONSIDERING the Regulation of the University of Naples Federico II regarding the processing of personal data, issued with D.R. 1226/2021;

CONSIDERING the Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement signed between Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II and Apple, for the establishment of the Developer Academy, for the training in the development of new applications and digital services, with the purpose – among others – to provide students admitted to the Apple Developer Academy with the necessary skills to become "developers" of innovative apps, i.e., professionals who can design, implement and commercialize innovative services on Apple technological platforms;

CONSIDERING that, as provided for by the aforesaid Scientific and Technological Cooperation Agreement and the Exhibit A – Project Addendum 1, is established a training course called “The Pier”;



GIVEN the Administration Board decree of 25th July 2016 and subsequents with which the administrative and accounting management has been entrusted to the Centro di Servizio di Ateneo per il Coordinamento dei Progetti Speciali e l’Innovazione Organizzativa dell’Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II – COINOR;

GIVEN the public notice of the Campania Region “Borse di studio per frequenza di academies regionali di livello internazionale in ambito ICT e digitale” ["Scholarships for attendance of regional academies of international level in the ICT and digital sectors"] - D.D. n. 174 of 01/08/2025, BURC n. 55 of 07/08/2025;

CONSIDERING that in response to the aforementioned Notice, the University of Naples Federico II presented the project “BRIDGE – Borse Regionali per l’innovazione Digitale e la Global Education” aimed at the implementation of highly qualifying training paths able to provide and strengthen digital skills and abilities of the recipients for an access or re-employment in the labor market;

GIVEN the Executive Decree of the Campania Region N. 30 of 01/10/2025 by which the ranking list for the Public Notice “Borse di studio per frequenza di academies regionali di livello internazionale in ambito ICT e digitale” ["Scholarships for attendance of regional academies of international level in ICT and digital"] was approved;

CONSIDERING that with Executive Decree N. 67 of 17/10/2025 the Project "BRIDGE – Borse Regionali per l’innovazione Digitale e la Global Education" has been admitted for funding from the PR Campania ESF+ 2021-2027 Priority 2 "Education and Training", Specific Objective ESO 4.7, ACTION LINE 2.g.5, for a total amount of € 8.924.014,00 (eight million nine hundred twenty-four thousand and fourteen euros);

CONSIDERING the administrative and accounting management of the Project “BRIDGE – Borse Regionali per l’innovazione Digitale e la Global Education” for the provision to the participants of the Apple Developer Academy of a contribution linked to their actual participation in the training activities has been entrusted to the “Centro di Servizio di Ateneo per il Coordinamento dei Progetti Speciali e l’Innovazione Organizzativa dell’Università degli Studi di Napoli Federico II COINOR; (COINOR) - (DR/2025/3768 of 09/09/2025);

CONSIDERING the Convention between the University of Naples Federico II and the Campania Region signed on October 31st, 2025 for the implementation of the project "BRIDGE – Borse



Regionali per l'innovazione Digitale e la Global Education" (CUP E64C25000150002 - CML OP_28122 25008AP000000001);

CONSIDERING also that, for the academic year 2026/2027 a total number of 25 students are expected to be admitted attending The Pier program after passing a specific selection.

DECLARES

SECTION 1

(Announcement and number of seats)

The University of Naples Federico II announces a selection of 25 students to be admitted to the PIER Program at the Apple Developer Academy.

The selection refers to the academic year 2026/2027.

SECTION 2

(Requirements for participation)

In order to be eligible for the selection mentioned in section 1, the applicant must have already attended the Apple Developer Academy in Naples in the academic year 2025/2026.

Candidates get a provisional admission to the selection. The University might decide to exclude any candidate, at any stage of this selection procedure, if the requirements are not fully met.

SECTION 3

(Application for participation in the selection procedure)

The 25 positions advertised are divided by skill profile as follows:

App Developer: 12

App Designer: 8

Project Manager: 5

The application form must be submitted exclusively on-line through the following website: <https://airtable.com/appzobgREPIRroB17/shrBht58bp3mQap6S>. On-line registration is available since the publication date of this announcement and will close mandatorily (and under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure) at **10:00 (CEST) of June 22nd 2026**.

Failure to comply with the regulations will prevent the admission to the selection and, in any case, result in an exclusion from the procedure.

All communications concerning the selection will be given exclusively via on-line publication on the Official Noticeboard of the University of Naples Federico II (available at the University website www.unina.it) and by publication on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 4

(Evaluation Committee)

The Evaluation Committee will be appointed after the final deadline for submission of the applications. Its composition will be announced through a notice, published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 5

(Selection procedure)

The selection procedure will consist in an evaluation of the presented documentation based on the criteria indicated in point 5 of Annex A.

SECTION 6

(Publication of the ranking list)

The merit ranking list will be drawn up only on the basis of the scores obtained through the evaluation. In case of a tie, the younger candidate will prevail.

The final ranking list will be published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

The final ranking will be published before June 29th, 2026. The selection procedure refers only to academic year 2026-2027.

SECTION 7

(Tuition fees and economic support funds)

The maximum financial contribution provided for participation in the training course BRIDGE – Regional Scholarships for Digital Innovation and Global Education of the Apple Developer Academy is set at €13,548.39 (thirteen thousand five hundred forty-eight/39), all-inclusive and gross of all charges borne by the beneficiary, in accordance with the tax rates and regulations in force at the date of disbursement of the attendance allowance.

The scholarship is treated as income equivalent to employment income, pursuant to Article 50, paragraph 1, letter c) of the Italian Consolidated Income Tax Act (TUIR), and is subject to IRPEF taxation by brackets according to ordinary rules. The scholarship holder shall be responsible for



fulfilling any tax obligations, where applicable, such as the submission of the income tax return. It is hereby specified that each beneficiary shall be personally responsible for the declarations submitted to the competent administration for the purposes of the disbursement of the contribution, whether erroneous or subsequently amended.

The attendance allowance shall be paid in a single instalment within 90 days from the end of the training programme, following verification of attendance through badge-based presence tracking and upon submission of the documentation required by the Study Plan approved by the entities and institutions providing the contribution.

Beneficiaries of the scholarship undertake to:

- Provide their bank and tax details no later than 60 (sixty) days after the conclusion of the training activities.
- Ensure that the data provided are complete, accurate, and up to date. It is hereby specified that each beneficiary shall be personally responsible for the declarations submitted to the competent administration for the purposes of the disbursement of the contribution, whether erroneous or subsequently amended.

In the event of failure to comply with the above obligations within the established deadline, the disbursement of the attendance allowance to which the student is entitled cannot be guaranteed if the delay in communicating the data compromises the completion of the financial reporting for the academic year 2026/2027 within the time limits set by the funding bodies.

The amount is strictly proportionate to the actual hours attended according to the academic calendar and, therefore, is not payable in the event of absence, even if justified, regardless of the reason (e.g. including illness and/or injury). The disbursement of attendance allowances to beneficiaries shall take place only after verification of actual attendance at the training activities.

A maximum number of absences, for any reason whatsoever, equal to 20% of the total training hours of the course, amounting to 1,500 hours, shall be permitted.

This calculation shall be carried out starting from the course start date according to the calendar prepared by the University of Naples Federico II.

Students who exceed this limit of permitted absences shall lose the right to receive the scholarship. Upon reaching 80% of the total hours envisaged, the amount of the attendance allowance shall be calculated on the basis of the hours of attendance actually completed.

The disbursement of the scholarship in question is incompatible with the receipt of other scholarships or similar grants or allowances during the period of attendance of the course.

SECTION 8

(Procedure of acceptance)

The admitted candidates must formalize their attendance to Apple Developer Academy by signing an agreement with which the admitted person undertakes to comply with the provisions of this



selection notice.

Once the deadline for acceptance has expired, if there are any seats left due to lack of acceptance or subsequent withdrawal, the ranking will be scrolled, in accordance with the required profile and the project involved. Any scrolling and the relative terms for making acceptances will be made known exclusively through publication on the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

SECTION 9

(Publication of the procedural acts)

This notice of selection and all documents attached will be published exclusively in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it.

The online publication in the Official website of the Apple Developer Academy has the force of notification with all effects and no personal messages will be sent to interested parties.

Therefore, it is recommended a constant consultation of the web link above.

SECTION 10

(Access to documents, Information regarding personal data)

Applicants have access to documents concerning the competition procedure, in accordance with the current legislation. This right will be exercised in the manner prescribed by the University Regulations laying down the rules on administrative procedure and the right of access to documents, issued with the Chancellor Decree n. 2386/98 and subsequent amendments and additions.

SECTION 11

(Privacy and information on personal data)

In accordance with the art. 13 of the EU Regulation 679/2016, the personal data collected will be processed for the purposes of the procedure for which they are released and will be used exclusively for this purpose and in any case within the Institutional activities of the University. The data controller is the University of Naples Federico II, in the persons of the Rector and the General Manager, in relation to their skills. SECTION 12 (Final Provisions)

The University reserves the right to exclude at any time the applicants participating in the procedure pursuant to this notice for failure to comply with its provisions or within the time specified or for default of the applicants' requirements. The exclusions are made with a Chancellor's Decree. Exclusions will be notified exclusively by online publication in the Official Noticeboard of the University (available at www.unina.it) and on the website www.developeracademy.unina.it. Please note that Annex is part of this announcement. We strongly recommend to carefully read the aforementioned document.
